What happens on testing day

- You will come to the library during your time slot
- You will check in with myself or Mr. Gongora
- You will then go and study for your test somewhere in the library
 - If you are in a solo event: study solo
 - If you are in a group event study with your group quietly, if you wish
 - Each member of your group tests **alone** and then the scores are averaged for a composite score
- When it is time for your test we will call your event/name/group and you will go test with the **proctor**
 - Yes, the tests are proctored. NOT OPEN NOTE
- Afterwards you will return to class
- Results will be posted on the gohosa.com website by December 5th.

What is Tallo?

Tallo is simply an online submission system. It allows some competitors to upload materials for competition early

Note: Not all competitions use Tallo, check your guidelines if you are unsure

Who uses Tallo?

The following competitions have an online submission on Tallo

1. Clinical Specialty
2. Health Career Display
3. Health Career Photography
4. Health Education
5. Job Seeking Skills
6. Medical Innovation

Some of the events listed are Pre-Judged on Tallo

This means that you have to submit something for your event and judges will critique it and you can gain and/or lose points based on what you turn in on Tallo.

The events that are pre-judged are

1. Health Career Display
2. Health Career Photography
3. Medical Innovation
4. Job Seeking Skills
5. Mental Health Promotion
6. Public Service Announcement

Finalists for events 1-3 will be given to Mr. Gongora 1 week before Area. Only those competitors that make it to finals will qualify for Area Competition.

Tallo (Continued)

All events that use Tallo must upload materials into Tallo by January 25, 2023 (see competitor orientation sheet for those materials)

The advisors will be checking to see if you uploaded before the deadline.

If you upload at 12:00 a.m. on January 26th you are late and it does not count

If you do not upload by the deadline you do not qualify for Mock Competition

What is Mock Competition?

Mock Competition allows us to see how prepared you are for Area

It also allows you to get a feel for competition day and helps you know what to expect on that day

If you appear lost or don't know AT LEAST the basics of what you are doing we will remove you from competition REGARDLESS of your test scores or any other details regarding your qualification

At this point there are no more refunds for competition. Time to learn and get ready. Mock will be here before you know it

Mock Competition

- Mock Competition is on Saturday January 21, 2023 from 8am-3pm in the CTE hallway
- You must have a suit/proper HOSA attire on when you arrive that day.
 - Unfortunately some events that submit on Tallo have a chance of being cut during round 1 judging before area. If that is the case for you, we are very sorry but at least you have a nice suit for the next wedding you go to :)
- All competitors put this in your calendar, reminder, text your guardian, do whatever you have to do to make sure that you are available all day on the 21st.
- The week of January 9-13 Mr. Gongora will be checking in with competitors to see your progress
- You must attend mock competition or else you will not go to Area.
- The schedule for Mock Competition will be released during the January General Meeting

One last thing
